The Two Angry Moms "Press Kit" is now available online as a PDF. You can print out the entire 24 pages of information or pick and choose which parts are most useful to you.



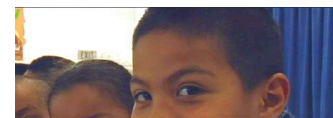
Included in the kit you'll find a single page summary of Two Angry Moms, the movie and the movement, as well as our five point action plan. Both are great as handouts at community events.
