**Is the food in your kids' school outsourced to a food service management company?**

When I began filming Two Angry Moms, I had questions about who was in charge of the food in our cafeterias and vending machines. I learned that my school district, like many in my area, was contracting with a corporate caterer (aka Food Service Management Company or FSMC). Enter Bob Pritsker, a neighbor who informed me of his ongoing investigation into the regulations and contracts governing school food outsourcing.

Bob Pritsker is one Angry Dad. He's angry about an alleged billion dollars skimmed from the National School Lunch Program via contracts manipulated by several large FSMCs. Recently we've seen our tax dollars wasted by military contractors and Wall Street partygoers but this is money taken out of the mouths of America's school kids. Many of these kids depend upon the school meals program for all or most of their daily nutrition.

Bob wasn't concerned about childhood obesity, type II diabetes or any of the myriad leaning and behavior disorders associated with the typical American child's diet. In fact, lobster tails, sushi and fresh garden greens are among some of the gourmet items on which his kids dine. He had moved his family from West coast to East coast to attend a top-rated public elementary school. Bob was simply appalled when he saw the poor quality fare proffered in the cafeteria. Bob has a law degree, an MBA, and he's former chef and fine restaurant owner. What he saw in the school cafeteria simply didn't make sense, so he embarked upon an investigation that has now occupied most of his time for the past four years.

His investigation has resulted in a lawsuit that is currently under review in Federal Court. Now that the lawsuit has been unsealed, we are finally able to discuss his case publicly. The series of four video clips on the angrymoms.org website exposes yet another example of corporate greed and abuse of government funds. In my interview with Bob, he explains how he identified a billion dollars that should have gone toward improving the quality of our not-for-profit school-based child nutrition programs that have instead been diverted into the coffers of some FSMCs. Bob's interview points out more opportunities to improve quality while maintaining a fiscally responsible school food program.

Let's keep our grassroots growing!
