ANGRY MOMS MOVIE UPDATE

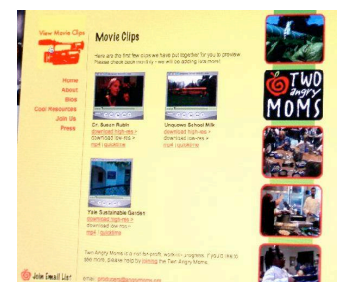


California Dreamin' – The Angry Moms production team is located in the Northeast. March and April are challenging times for us to source our food locally. A couple of years ago, I had the privilege of interviewing Chef Ann Cooper (for an episode of Martha Stewart Living) while she was the head of Wellness for the Ross School in Eastern Long Island. Ann and her staff had implemented a school lunch program that was not only organic, it was also seasonally and regionally sourced, year round! Chef Ann is now head of food service for the Berkeley California Unified School District. Our crew is heading out to Berkeley in April to follow Ann around as she implements her healthy school lunch program in this inner city district serving 20,000 students daily. We're hoping that Ann's program will serve as a model for public schools across the country.

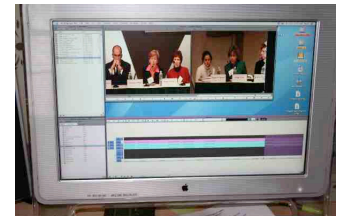
CALLING ALL KIDS
